

Preface

Volumina Jurassica, a journal supported by the International Subcommittee on Jurassic Stratigraphy, is a peer-reviewed geological journal devoted to the publication of original research papers on all aspects of the Jurassic System. Over the past eight years the format of the journal has been gradually modified. Rapidly growing interest from authors and readers worldwide has made the editors aware that there is a significant need for an international journal specializing in the Jurassic. Our intention is to expand the current position of *Volumina Jurassica*. At the moment, we plan to issue one volume per year on a regular basis, but we are ready to increase the number of issues per year if there is such a need.

Volumina Jurassica is issued jointly by the Polish Geological Institute – National Research Institute (PGI–NRI), and University of Warsaw. The editorial office is now in the PGI–NRI, which secures a stable organizational framework and financial support.

The principal editorial staff of *Volumina Jurassica* are Andrzej Wierzbowski (editor-in-chief), Grzegorz Pieńkowski (deputy editor) and Anna Andraszek (secretary). The Advisory Editorial Board of the journal comprises 16 prominent Jurassic geologists from many countries. Linguistic advice is provided by Dr John Wright. *Volumina Jurassica* is a free access journal (pdf's are fully accessible on the web page), 500 paper copies are printed, and are shipped without charge to authors, reviewers and selected libraries.
